



NATURHAUS Natural Resin Patina Stains

Product information:	NATURHAUS <i>Natural Resin Patina Stains</i> are an alcohol-based, fast-drying, slightly film-forming interior colouring matter made of natural resins such as shellac and copal and micronized earth- and mineral pigments. It is available in many different colours miscible in all proportions. The hiding power and the end tone desired can be adjusted by mixing with either NATURHAUS <i>Natural Resin Primer "Clear"</i> (Prod. No. 92900) or NATURHAUS <i>Master Batches for Patina Stains</i> (Prod. Nos. 92953 - 92957). The product has been developed specifically for tinting wooden furniture and other slightly exposed interior wooden surfaces. It can also be safely used for children's furniture such as baby cribs, high chairs, tables and toys. The product has exceptional coverage and will reveal and enhance the natural attributes of wooden surfaces.			
Ingredients:	Unbleached shellac, copal, natural rosin ester, micronized earth- and mineral pigments, ethanol and triple-refined orange oil.			
Application:	① Colouring of Untreated Wooden Surfaces: Stir well before use. Grind surface finally with 180-grit to 240-grit sandpaper and apply product using airmix spraying techniques. The wood-grain of softwoods is enhanced by high air flow (dry spraying) and diminished by low air flow (wet spraying). Allow to dry for 20 to 30 minutes, then wipe surface lightly with a lint-free cloth to remove particles. The maximum moisture content for softwoods and hardwoods should not exceed 12 percent. ② Colour Levelling of Oiled and Waxed Surfaces: Stir well before use and apply product using airmix spraying at high air flow and allow to dry for 20 to 30 minutes. Excessive patina stain can be removed with a lint-free cloth moistened in NATURHAUS <i>Alcohol Thinner</i> (Prod. No. 92801). ③ Tinting of NATURHAUS Natural Resin Primer: Stir well before use and add up to 30 % of the product to NATURHAUS <i>Natural Resin Primer "High filling"</i> (Prod. No. 92809). Clean spots and tools with NATURHAUS <i>Alcohol Thinner</i> (Prod. No. 92801).			
Further treatment:	① NATURHAUS <i>Hard Oils</i> (Prod. Nos. 00210, 00214, 00250), <i>Hard Wax</i> (Prod. No. 01050), <i>Hard Wax Oil</i> (Prod. No. 01500); ② and ③ NATURHAUS <i>Hard Wax</i> (Prod. No. 01050), <i>Hard Wax Oil</i> (Prod. No. 01500).			
Drying time:	approximately 20 - 30 minutes, depending on temperature and relative humidity.			
Physical properties:	Density: approx. 0.82 g/ml; viscosity approx. 11 seconds (ISO 2431, 4 mm).			
Coverage:	17 - 85 m ² per l (10 - 50 g/m ²), depending on the absorbency of the surface.			
Test specifications:	DIN EN 71-3 (security requirements for toys intended for children).			
Hazard classification:	<i>Highly flammable (F, R11)</i> according to Council Directive 1999/45/EEC.			
Storing conditions:	Keep the original container tightly closed and store in a dry, cool, frost-free and well ventilated area. The product can be stored up to 2 years.			
Security and disposal information:	Keep product away from children. Keep away from sources of ignition and refrain from smoking. Ventilate working area during application and drying. Do not allow to enter drains, surface waters and groundwater. Empty containers completely and send to a licensed recycler.
